

Admission to a School Nursery Classes

I haven't been offered a place. Can my child's name be kept on the waiting list?

You don't need to do anything. Your child's name has been automatically included on the waiting list for the nursery class you asked for and the local authority will contact you directly if we are able to offer a place in the future.

How do I ask for my child to be considered for a place at one of these nursery classes?

You must complete an NR2 form to let us know which nursery class you would like your child considered for. This can be downloaded from the borough website www.enfield.gov.uk/admissions. You can scan the completed form and email to esas@enfield.gov.uk or send it to the Enfield Schools Admission Service, Civic Centre, Silver Street, Enfield, EN1 3XA.

Can I make an application for more than one nursery class?

*Yes. You can include more than one school on the form. You **must** list the nursery classes in order of preference (let us know which of these nursery classes you would prefer the most). The places available will be offered according to the published admissions criteria.*

Can my child go to a playgroup or private nursery?

Yes, the Government has made funding available to provide free, part time nursery education for all three and four year old children. You can get information about playgroups, private nurseries and other pre-school provision from Informed Families, on the website www.enfield.gov.uk/if.
