Dear Sir / Madam,

I am writing to you on behalf of the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, in your capacity as a local stakeholder or representative of a local organisation / public body / community group etc. with an interest in, or local to the London Borough of Enfield.

The Boundary Commission started an electoral review of the London Borough of Enfield in July. The purpose of an electoral review is to consider:

- the number of Councillors elected to the Council,
- the number & names of wards,
- the ward boundaries and,
- the number of Councillors per ward.

As part of the review process, Commission staff would like to brief community groups and other stakeholders in Enfield to tell you about the review and how you can get involved. The Commission has found that positive engagement with communities during the review process leads to better submissions and, ultimately, better outcomes for reviews.

The ward boundaries of every council in the country are reviewed from time to time to ensure they are in the right places and there is roughly the same number of electors in each ward. Enfield was last reviewed in 2000 and the Commission feels this is the right time for this to be done again. The new boundaries will come into force at the local elections in 2022.

The briefing will take place **on Wednesday 7 November 2018, starting at 7pm** in the Conference Room at the Civic Centre, Silver Street, Enfield EN1 3XA. It will consist of a short presentation from the Commission, followed by plenty of time for questions.
